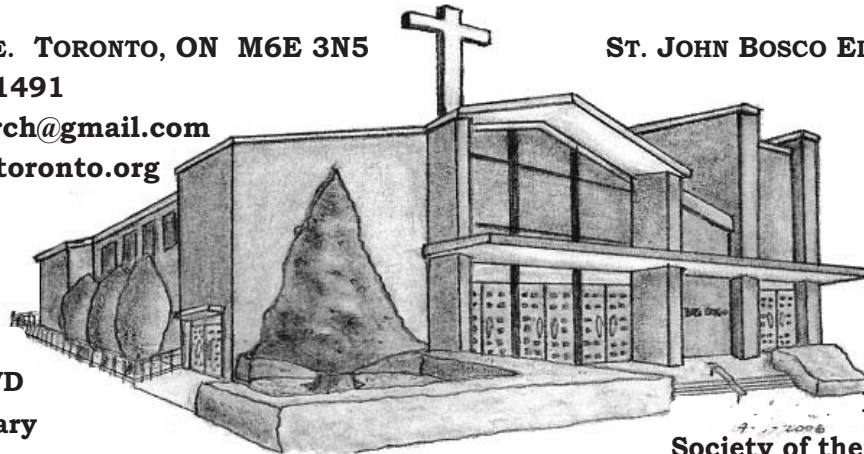

Please note that our masses will be on a first come basis. We have a limited amount of seats. We ask for your co-operation and patience in helping our volunteers, to make it safe for everyone. Please wear a mask (by-law- mandatory) when coming to mass.

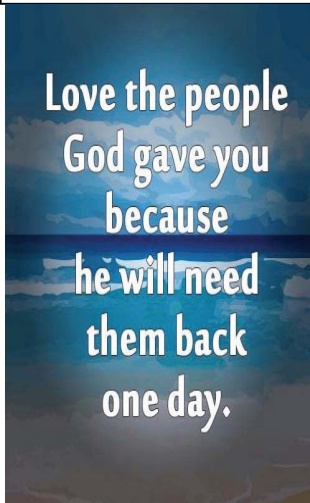

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Spiritual Communion is a way to be united with Christ when we cannot physically receive the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist. It can be made at home or in church, in front of the Blessed Sacrament or not.

How do I do it?

Start with the sign of the cross and prayer.

Read and reflect on the [readings from Mass that day](#).

Have a real desire to be united with Christ.

Acknowledge your sins and ask for pardon and forgiveness.

Receive Christ in your soul and pray an act of Spiritual Communion (see below).

Offer thanksgiving.

St. Alphonsus Liguori's Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

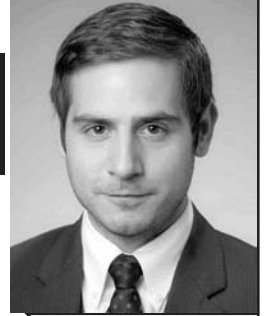
