It can be made at home or in church, in front of the Blessed Sacrament or not. How do I do it? Start with the sign of the cross and prayer. Read and reflect on the readings from Mass that day. Have a real desire to be united with Christ. Acknowledge your sins and ask for pardon and forgiveness. Receive Christ in your soul and pray an act of Spiritual Communion (see below). Offer thanksgiving.
