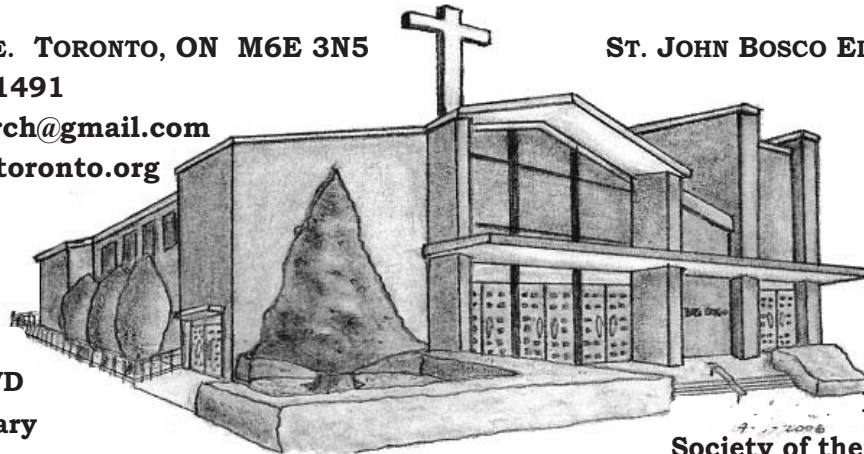

**Prayer to Mother Mary**

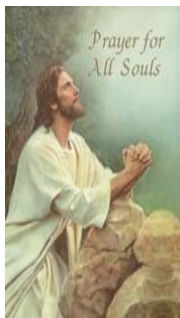

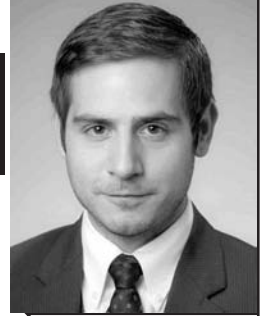
