Transitional Diaconate Ordinations - September 13, 2025

A significant milestone for four men currently studying for the priesthood will take place on

Saturday, September 13, 2025, at 10:00 a.m.

This marks the day that they will be ordained to the transitional diaconate, one of the high points in their years of priestly formation through St. Augustine's Seminary and the Redemptoris Mater Missionary Seminary in Toronto.

The Most Rev. John A. Boissonneau, Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Toronto, will preside at this year's transitional diaconate ordinations, which will take place at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica.

The transitional diaconate is an important stage in the Sacrament of Holy Orders for those men who are preparing for the priesthood. While all deacons are ordained for service to the Church, those in the transitional diaconate are on a path to becoming priests, with permanent deacons remaining in the diaconal order.

The men currently in formation who will be ordained to the transitional diaconate are as follows: Matteo Bertozzi, Moonjun Alphonse Choi, Matthew Tulio, Victor Valdés

All are welcome to attend the ordinations and we invite the Catholic community throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto to continue to pray for these men and all those who are currently in formation, that the Lord may guide and strengthen them along the journey.

Devotion to Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is held every first Wednesday of the Month. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary are two significant expressions of Catholic spirituality, focusing on the love and mercy of Jesus and the compassion and purity of Mary. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus emphasizes Christ's immense love for humanity, as symbolized by His heart. This devotion is rooted in Scripture, where Jesus invites believers to learn from His heart, which is "meek and humble" (Matthew 11:29). It became more formalized in the seventeenth century through the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun. In these visions, Jesus revealed His heart as a source of divine love, wounded by sin but overflowing with mercy. The Immaculate Heart of Mary devotion focuses on the interior life of Mary, her virtues, and her deep love for God and humanity. It is particularly tied to her maternal compassion and sorrow for the sins of the world.
